Annual Photo Contest

The Contest is open to all amateur photographers. For our purposes, an amateur photographer is a person who does not receive the majority of their income from photography.

There will be two categories: Adult and Student (under age 18)

There are no limitations on style, theme, subject, or editing. However, due to space considerations, pieces must not exceed 30" in any direction (this includes any mat or frame). Images must be printed on either paper or canvas. No metal, glass, wood, etc. prints. The images must be either framed, or mounted in such a way as to be ready to hang with either wire, metal loop or a saw-tooth hanger. The museum will not install wires and hangers on your artwork.

Images must be actual photographs, taken with a traditional film/digital camera, or phone. No computer-designed graphic art will be accepted. However, photographs may be edited, including applying digital effects with Photoshop, Lightroom, Snapseed, etc.. The art must be original work of the submitting photographer. This includes all major elements of composite images.

Judging will be by a panel of three photographers/artists who will rate the images based on their creativity, originality, and beauty. Any identifying marks, signatures, logos on the images will be covered for judging.

Artist may submit up to 5 images. The cost to enter is \$25 per artist for one photo. Additional photos will be \$5 each.

There will be three awards in each category (Adult & Student) 1st place will receive \$100, 2nd place will receive \$75, and 3rd place will receive \$50.

The deadline to enter is August 25th 2025. The artwork will be displayed in our gallery for the entire month of September. The winners will be announced at the artist reception, September 21st, from 6:00 -8p.m..
